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Statement of Area Variance Criteria

SIGNATURE

In accordance with Section 410.230 and 410.240 of the City Code of the City of Pleasant Valley, the applicant must meet each of the following requirements to support the granting of the requested variance. *Failure to complete each may result in an incomplete application.* Describe in detail how this application meets each of the following requirements. The person completing this form must sign at the bottom.

1.	The variance requested arises from a condition which is unique and peculiar to the property in question and which is not ordinarily found in the same zone or district, and further, is not created by an action or actions of the property owner or applicant.
2.	The granting of the variance will not adversely affect the rights of adjacent property owners or residents.
3.	Strict Application of the provisions of the City's zoning regulations of which the variance is requested will constitute practical difficulties for the property owner. Missouri Courts have stated that the following factors are helpful in determining practical difficulties:
	 (1) How substantial the deviation (variance) is in relation to the requirement; (2) Whether there will be a substantial change in the character of the neighborhood or a substantial detriment to adjoining properties; (3) Can the problem be corrected by a feasible alternative to the grant of a variance; (4) Whether fairness can be achieved for all by allowing the variance
4.	The granting of the variance will not be opposed to the general spirit and intent of the ordinance from which the variance is sought.
5.	The variance requested will not adversely affect the public health, safety, morals, or general welfare of the community.
6.	Substantial justice will be done by the granting of this variance. (Why is this request fair to all affected?)
